Make an attractive 3D Model of the allotted house by reusing and recycling materials like newspaper roll, old cardboard sheets, colours etc with the help of your parents.

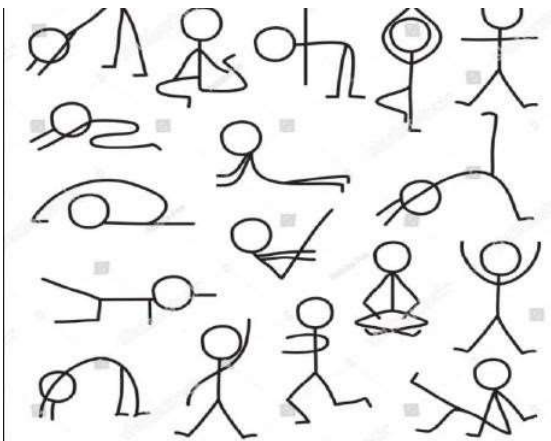

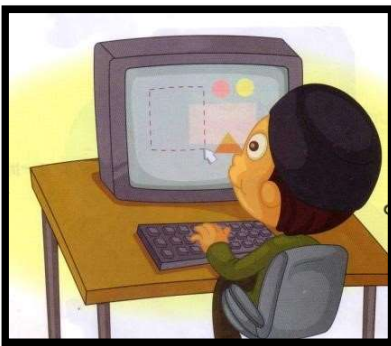
